Chamber Cleaning Details:

Using Cleaning Kit Handle Assy., Metric to Standard Rod Adapter, & 9mm brush to clean chamber neck.



The end of the Cleaning Kit Handle shown above (with the 9mm chamber neck brush and metric to std. rod adapter assembled to it) is aligned with the rear of the upper receiver as a "penetration" guide.



Chamber Neck area to be cleaned with 9mm brush.

"Fit" of 9mm Brush in Chamber Neck.

Handle Front Edge used as 9mm brush penetration limit indicator—do not push it in any further.





Bore Snake (PN: GA1016) The "Bore Snake" can be washed by hand with soap & water, or machine washed inside of a knotted sock or wash bag. The "Bore Snake" is a quick field expedient method of chamber and bore cleaning when either the time, or the complete cleaning kit, is not available or practical. It is best used with the bolt carrier removed, so the brass weight on the small end can be dropped straight down the bore. Then pull slowly being careful not to snag on the receiver edges as the big end is pulled through the chamber & bore. A few drops of bore cleaner may be added to the area in front of the embedded brass bore brush to aid in cleaning, and likewise gun oil added to the big end for lubrication & protection.



Carbon Brush (PN: GA1015) This brass bristle "Carbon Brush" is for the tail-end of the bolt and the suppressor interface so the User will not wear out the bore or chamber brushes removing the baked-on carbon from those areas.
